- 3- Should you be approved to adopt, you are NOT purchasing a dog. You are making a donation towards the medical needs of future incoming rescued canines.
- 4- Your adoption donation is non-refundable.
- 5- Schnauzer Rescue of the Carolinas will pursue legal action against any adopter who relinquishes an adopted dog to another party (to include but not be limited to: a shelter, pound, individual, family, or rescue group) without the expressed written consent of a Board Member of Schnauzer Rescue of the Carolinas. Any adopter found to have relinquished an adopted dog will be responsible for all fees incurred by Schnauzer Rescue of the Carolinas in association with reclaiming the adopted dog.
- 6- Adopting a dog from a rescue group is a commitment to the adopted dog for its lifetime. Schnauzer Rescue of the Carolinas cannot guarantee that it will accept a dog back into rescue once it is adopted.
- 7- Your application will be reviewed, references will be contacted, a home visit will be scheduled, and a phone interview will be conducted prior to final approval.
- 8- ***We reserve the right to refuse adoption without explanation to the applicant. Submitting an application does not guarantee you will receive a rescued dog.***
